CONSENT ORDER

It is hereby consented and otherwise stipulated by Defendant City of Wildwood, New Jersey, and Plaintiff Eric Wollod that:

1. Plaintiff has filed a complaint for a permanent injunction against Defendant City of Wildwood, requesting that the Court enjoin Wildwood from enforcing City Ordinance § 7 that requires individuals wishing to distribute literature on public sidewalks or the boardwalk to obtain a permit.
2. On April 30, 2009, the Court dismissed this case after learning that the parties were in the process of settlement (Document 11). The Court retained jurisdiction to enforce the terms and conditions of the settlement.
3. Defendant agrees that Plaintiff, while acting as an individual, will be permitted to engage in religious speech, whether through distribution of

literature or conversation, on all public forums in the City of Wildwood, including public sidewalks, parks, and boardwalks without having to obtain a permit or pay a fee or otherwise obtain prior permission or approval from the City.


4. The City agrees to amend its ordinances so that individuals (as opposed to larger groups) will not be required to obtain a permit or otherwise obtain prior permission or pay a fee to engage in religious speech, whether through distribution of literature or conversation, on all public forums in the City of Wildwood, including public sidewalks, parks, and boardwalks.
5. The City agrees to pay the Defendant's counsel attorneys fees and costs in the amount of \$15,500, which represents the total damages claimed by Plaintiff in this case.
6. Based on this agreement, Plaintiff agrees to release the City from any further liability arising from the facts as stated in Plaintiff's complaint.

By the Stipulation of the Parties, and for good cause showing, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this case and has jurisdiction over all parties to this Consent Order;
2. Venue properly lies with this Court;

3. Plaintiff Eric Wollod, while acting as an individual, shall be permitted to engage in religious speech, whether through distribution of literature or conversation, on all public forums in the City of Wildwood, including public sidewalks, parks, and boardwalks without having to obtain a permit or pay a fee or otherwise obtain prior permission or approval from the City.
4. Defendant shall amend its ordinances to reflect that individuals (as opposed to larger groups) are not required to obtain a permit or otherwise obtain prior permission or pay a fee to engage in religious speech, whether through distribution of literature or conversation, on all public forums in the City of Wildwood, including public sidewalks, parks, and boardwalks within 90 days of this order.
5. The Defendant shall pay Plaintiff's counsel \$15,500 in attorneys fees and costs within 30 days of this order.
